a. Joe Larson reported on ongoing projects:

Nathan Posey:	Pavers at the Kiosk plus plants
Will Hill:	Sealing the retention walls at flag pole and admin area

Joe also reported that Prestige was still doing fund raisers for Wreaths Across America they have raised \$1,200 so far and will turn the money over in December. Joe will purchase 500 more wreaths. They received a Grant from Wal Mart for \$500.00. Joe said they are also doing 3x5 display boards in the Kiosk area. Should be completed in 1 ½ weeks they are having trouble finding pavers. Old Business: Larry McKim, presented the new logo and wording on the two plaques to be presented to Gary Abrahams and Mike Rutherford. When they will be presented to these two individuals will be determined at a later date. Joe Larson brought the new pins and coins we ordered. The pins were \$1.66 each and the coins were \$4.16 each. A motion was made and approved to charge \$5.00 per pin. A motion was made and approved to charge \$10.00 for per coin. Joe Larson suggested at the June meeting to do a business card of what the Foundation was about, our web site and etc. Joe decided to make the cards himself at this time at no cost to the Foundation.

New Business: Bill Pakinkis, the new Commander of American Legion Post #24 stated the American Legion wants to be a part of the Cemetery Foundation, will bring a check at the September meeting. Joe Larson asked that \$1,000 to be moved to the Pay Pal Account, for \$500.00 for Wreaths, and \$500.00 to the General Account. A motion was made and approved. Leo made a motion to replace the dead plants around the area and not to exceed \$1,000.00 motion approved. Joe Larson ask that people bring in their bags to be retired, he has 6, 33 gallon bags of flags to be retired. He said staff can do the flag retirement.. Bill Pakinkis stated this has to be done on flag day. Joe Larson stated that as long as it is dignified can be done at anytime. Ingrid Bailliebrou brought up about nylon flags cannot be burned because of matting together, the smell, etc. She said the American Legion recycles them. This will be researched and more information at the September meeting will be forthcoming.

Good for the Order – Conny DeSpain and Ron will be gone until the November meeting. Ingrid Baillie volunteered to do the minutes. Joe Larson will bring the Bank Statements and the expenditures for the two months for Ron DeSpain Ron DeSpain brought some pins with the Foundations name on them that he purchased himself. Gave everyone one and had also gave Joe Larson some to be given out at the Cemetery. Ron DeSpain loaned the cemetery a bell to be used for services. A motion was made and approved to buy one for the Cemetery monies not to exceed \$300.00. Will buy in December. Earl Devine knows of a source that might give us one then we would not have to buy one.
